Tuition Rates

All 4-week Periods contain 4 full weeks of classes and each Quarter contains 12 full weeks of classes - you DO NOT PAY for our Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring breaks. NO additional insurance and registration fees! All classes are school-year long; once registered, that space in the class is yours all school year; if you decide not to continue beyond any paid-for period of time, please call or email us.

DISCOUNTS on classes that meet weekly:

1. QUARTERLY - 3% if paid during first 2 weeks of Quarter or year. (NO Refunds)
2. FAMILY - 3% from combined tuition (FULL Periods, Quarters, year). (NO refunds)
3. MULTIPLE CLASS - Tuition reduced as one student takes more classes per week - see above.

TRIAL CLASSES: ¼ of the regular once per week, 4-week tuition for that class (one class only.)

MAKE-UP CLASSES: If you miss any class for any reason (illness, vacation, injury, snow, etc.), you may make up that class by attending a similar class at the Olympia location (classes are offered 5 days a week) within the 4-week Period (or within the next week if you're a continuing student and you've missed in the last week of the 4-week Period), or within the Quarter if you've paid by the Quarter. You may make up classes ahead of absences within 4 weeks; sign in "make-up for (date)." If you don't make up missed classes, they are lost. (Exceptions will be made with a doctor's excuse.) No refunds; no credit carried over or transferred.
