Please read all information to ensure that the recital runs smoothly and your dancer is prepared. We take pride in the quality of our recitals. If you have suggestions on how to make photo day, rehearsal day, or recital day run more smoothly please let us know.

Last Tuition Payments

Tuition will be charged May 18 for the last time this school year if you pay by the 4-week Period. If you pay by the Quarter, your last payment was in March. Your child will not be allowed to participate in the recital if her/his tuition is not up to date or if responsible party has not made arrangements with Ken to pay at a later time. We will be emailing out links to the recital music. During these last few weeks, make sure to practice outside of class. (This is especially important if your child has recently missed classes.) Some children need this practice more than others.

Costumes, Make-Up, Hair

Costumes will be handed out this month. At class we will help one child into her/his costume so everyone will see how each part of the costume should be used; the other children will bring their costumes home in an unopened bag. This will allow you some time to make any necessary fitting adjustments, get hair adjusted to headpieces/hats, attach ribbon or elastic to hats to hold them to children's heads, etc. Please try on costume within next couple days, and keep smaller pieces such as headpieces, gloves, etc. with the costume so they do not get lost.

Children should not play in their costumes between the time it arrives, getting dressed for the photo session, rehearsal, and recital – too much chance for it to get stained or ripped. After the recital, the costumes are yours to keep.

It's highly advisable to wear costume to photo session, rehearsal, and recital. Change out of costume immediately after photo session and rehearsal. DON'T eat or drink in costume. Please do not bring food or drinks into Johansen Olympia Dance Center on photo day or into the dressing rooms or theater at the Washington Center.

For PHOTOS, REHEARSAL, and RECITAL (unless teacher specifies other):

- A. BALLET: pink tights/shoes with tutu costumes, darker skinned dancers may wear flesh-colored tights and flesh colored soft ballet slippers that match the color of their tights (tights should be matte not shiny or Lycra), or black tights/dance pants/shoes for costumes with shirt/vest. Long hair must be contained in a bun and off of the face and neck. Hair should be done before arrival. If you think you will have trouble with the hair, start practicing now. We must see your entire neck, forehead, and ears. Short haired dancers must have their hair off the face and held still

with hair product. Make sure strings of ballet slippers are taped in and dancer's name is written inside shoes with a permanent marker. Here are some helpful links to help do that perfect ballet bun for recital...

B. JAZZ

- Middle Jazz: high ponytail, black jazz shoes.
- Advanced Jazz: high ponytail, black jazz shoes.
- Teen/Adult Jazz: high ponytail, black jazz shoes.

C. TAP

- Tap K-2nd: high ponytail, suntan tights, black tap shoes.
- Elementary Tap: high ponytail, suntan tights, black tap shoes.
- Middle Tap: high ponytail, suntan tights, black tap shoes.
- Teen/Adult Tap: hair down with front pulled back into small ponytail, low cut black socks or black tights, black tap shoes.
- Advanced Tap: ponytail or hair half up/half down, black tap shoes.

D. CONTEMPORARY

- Elementary: barefeet and hair half up/half down no part.
- Intermediate: flesh toned ballet slippers and hair in high pony tail at crown of head/no part.
- Advanced: catspaw on feet and hair in low pony tail.

E. HIP-HOP: sneakers that are clean and not worn outside. Hair should be pulled back from face.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR ALL: No panties under girls' tights (they hang below the costume looking unsightly), and no nail polish. No jewelry of any kind. (If dancers have newly pierced ears, they must be covered with flesh-colored bandaids.)

MAKE-UP (unless teacher specifies otherwise): lipstick & blush so the dancer is not washed out onstage (NOT fire-engine red.) Eye make-up (shadow, liner and mascara) is optional.

If you wish to take pictures or videos of the dancers, you may do so during the rehearsals. NO PICTURES OR VIDEOS DURING THE RECITALS. Bright lights, clicking, and movement are dangerous and distracting to the dancers, as well as distracting to the audience.

Pre-Purchasing JODC T-Shirts, Sweatshirts, and Duffel Bags

Purchase new JODC logo wear by May 22 and they will be available for pick-up in the Washington Center lobby on recital day. (No merchandise will be available for purchase on site at the recital – see email for link to purchase.)

Pre-Purchasing Personalized JODC Tumblers

Purchase a personalized JODC tumbler or water bottle by May 31 and they will be available for pick-up in the Washington Center lobby on recital day. (No merchandise will be available for purchase on site at the recital – see email for link to purchase.)

Professional Videos

Professional videos will be shot on recital day (one for each recital). Free video downloads are included with your recital fee and a link will be emailed out after the recital. Free livestreaming will be available as well.

Professional Photos: Saturday, June 1 at Johansen Olympia Dance Center

Group and individual photos will be shot at Johansen Olympia Dance Center, June 1 – assigned times are listed later in the packet. As we did last year, our photographer will photograph each dancer individually then use these to create the group photo (they turned out great last year!) Unlike previous years, photos will be available for purchase online after photo day (a link will be emailed out.)

To ease congestion on photo day, each dancer will be allowed only one parent to accompany them into the dance center on photo day. Adults will not be allowed in the room where photos are being taken – parents may wait in the neighboring studio for their dancer. Parents can take their own photos in the back studio while they wait.

Rehearsal: Saturday, June 8, at the Washington Center

Please do not drop off in parking lot directly behind Washington Center. Keep alley clear of cars, and walk your child to the theater. Only one adult per dancer is allowed for dressing room drop off and pick up. Please enter to the dressing rooms through "Stage Door #1" (in parking alley between Washington Business Bank and the Washington Center) and exit from dressing rooms through "Stage Door #2" (a little farther down the alley). Dressing rooms are downstairs. Please check-in with the attendant at the location bearing the name of your dance – dancers will stay in the area as they wait to rehearse. After rehearsing twice in a row on stage, the dancers will be returned to the dressing rooms to be picked up ASAP by their parent or responsible adult. After dropping off your dancer, you need to go out "Stage Door #2" then around the outside of the building to the front entrance door at 512 S. Washington Street then vice versa to "Stage Door #1" to pick up your dancer as soon as their two practices in a row are finished.

While each group practices their dance on stage, you may take pictures or videos from the audience section of the theater during rehearsals (not during recitals). You may not cross stage or side stage area at any time. There will be attendants in charge of being with your child's group until they are picked up. They also have other jobs to do so please pick up your child as promptly as possible. No dancer should leave the dressing rooms unless picked up by a parent or responsible adult. If your child is in more than one rehearsal and has time in between and you feel she/he is responsible enough to leave the building alone, we need a note or email from you before that day.

To watch rehearsals before your child's rehearsal, just come early into the theater; be sure to be backstage in time for your dancer's rehearsal. (Exiting the theater and entering "Stage Door #1.") After their rehearsals, dancers are free to leave or watch remaining rehearsals quietly (no running, eating or drinking in any part of the theater.) If your child wishes to watch after their own rehearsal, you may use the same route to get back into the main entrance of the theater (exiting Stage Door #2.) Dancers can't watch any part of their own recital – they can watch other recitals in which they are not dancing. (So rehearsal day is a good day to come see some of the other dances.) Rehearsals are from 10:00-7:00. It's ok to watch rehearsals and recitals in costume, but please change out of costume as soon as you get home. After the recital, the costume is yours to do with as you wish.

Recital: Sunday, June 9 at the Washington Center

Each dancer may invite as many people as they wish to watch the recital. There is no admission charge and there are no tickets. Seating is general admission. Please be considerate of others and do not save seats for large groups.

All dancers must remain backstage from beginning to end of entire recital. Each dance is done only once. All audience members must stay in their seats. Entire recital lasts no more than 60 minutes. Dancers may not watch any part of their own recital. After each recital is finished, all dancers will remain in dressing rooms with her/his group until picked up by a parent or other responsible person. If you want your older child to meet you at the backstage door, we must have a note or email from you. Please send only one person to dressing room to pick up your child. If you must make an early departure, you must clear it with Ken ahead of time and email us. When dropping off and picking up your dancer in dressing rooms, please always enter through back of building "Stage Door #1" and exit through "Stage Door #2. You may not cross any stage area or backstage area to or from the audience. (Not even Ballet Northwest dancers and families.)

We've scheduled three recitals this year (12:00, 2:30, 5:00). Most dancers who take one class per week are in one recital only. Some dancers who take more than one class or style of dance (or advanced classes) are in more than one recital. We try to put siblings in the same recital, but this is not always possible. For the benefit of those attending the next recital, please clear out of the theater as soon as possible. If you're arriving for the next recital, please be patient and don't take your children into the dressing room before the assigned time. We try to make our recitals very professional, quick, and pleasant for dancers and audiences. To help us accomplish this:

- A. Please leave your child/children backstage until the END of their own recital, and then pick them up as quickly possible (in door #1, out door #2).
- B. If you have one child in one recital and one in the next, please make the exchange as quickly as possible between shows but not until the assigned arrival time. Each child can watch the other child's recital (in costume is OK). No dancer can watch any part of her/his own recital.
- C. If your dancer wants to watch some of the other kids dance, please do so at the dress rehearsal on Saturday, not the recitals unless you have family or friends in another recital.
